Subject: Setting up of Power Generation Plant of 1.20 MW capacity using Biogas produced from Starch Industry Effluent by M/s Gujarat Ambuja Exports Ltd. at Jalgaon, Maharashtra – Sanction of Project – Reg.

Sir,

This is with reference to letter dated 24.07.2017 from the Maharashtra Energy Development Agency (MEDA), Pune forwarding therewith proposal for Central Financial Assistance (CFA) for setting up of above mentioned project by M/s Gujarat Ambuja Exports Ltd. at a total cost of Rs. 675.00 lakh.

2. I am directed to convey the sanction of the President for grant of **CFA of Rs. 1.20 crores (Rupees One Crore twenty lakhs Only)** as subsidy to M/s Gujarat Ambuja Exports Ltd. on reimbursement basis and Rs.1,20,000/- (Rupees One Lakhs twenty thousand Only) to MEDA, as Service Charges in respect of above mentioned project.

3. The CFA will be released to M/s Gujarat Ambuja Exports Ltd. at Jalgaon, Maharashtra and Service Charges to MEDA only after successful commissioning of the project as per DPR norms and receipt of requisite project related information/documents. The conditions of successful commissioning of the project would, *inter-alia*, imply operation of the project for three months, including at least 72 hours continuous operation at minimum of 80% of rated capacity.

4. The grantee organization will not change or make any deviation in the specific details of the project to be undertaken as given in para-1 without prior concurrence of this Ministry. The sanctioned project shall be completed within a period of nine months from the date of sanction, failing which this sanction will be treated as cancelled unless prior permission for extension is obtained from the Ministry.

5. The beneficiary organization is required to submit the following documents as per Scheme guidelines dtd. 18.05.2017 duly certified by the officials of State Nodal Agency (SNA) at the time of release of CFA:-

- (i) Document indicating the commissioning date
- (ii) Board Resolution for meeting the project cost from internal accruals/Bank
- (iii) Under taking for not claiming subsidy from other institution on non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 100/-
- (iv) Inspection report of the Project by Executive Engineer of SNA
- (v) Performance report of power generation for a period of 3 consecutive months
- (vi) Power generation data for 72 hours continuous operation at minimum 80% rated capacity
- (vii) Valid Consent to Operate from State Pollution Control Board (SPCB).
- (ix) Analysis report of Effluent quantity and characteristics form accredited lab if applicable
- (x) Statement of Expenditure made so far, duly certified by C.A. with seal and Firm Registration No. & C.A. Membership No.
- (xi) Bank letter(s) for disbursement of the sanctioned amount for the project, if applicable

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- (xii) Mandate form for payment transfer of promoter
- (xiii) Brief Write up on Project as per **Annexure 2**.
- (xiv) Soft and Hard copy of the high resolution colour photographs

7. All the terms and conditions stipulated in the Administrative Approval for the Programme on Energy from Urban, Industrial and Agricultural Wastes/Residues dtd. 18.05.2017 have to be followed.

8. MEDA will closely monitor the project implementation progress & performance and submit periodical reports to the Ministry. **Release of Rs. 1,20,000/- to MEDA is towards Service Charges and No UC is required.**

9. M/s Gujarat Ambuja Exports Ltd. at Jalgaon, Maharashtra is a Private Company and is covered under 'F' category' with reference to Controller of Accounts O.M. No. PAO/MNRE/Sanction/2005-06, dated 11.07.2005.

10. As per the provision contained in Rule 236 of GFR-2017, the accounts of the grantee organizations shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office by the Ministry.

11. The expenditure involved is debit to Demand No. 69, MNRE, Major Head '2810' New and Renewable Energy, 00.101- Grid Interactive and Distributed Renewable Power, 02-Off Grid/Distributed and Decentralized Renewable Power, 03 Bio power, 02.03.35 Grant for Creation of Capital Assets and head 03 Bio power, 02.03.31 Grant in aid for service charges for the year 2019-20 (allocations).

12. This sanction issues in exercise of the delegated powers and with the concurrence of IFD vide their Diary No. 555 dated 04.03.2020.


